- Hugues II de (Tiberias) Falkenberg, prince of Galilee, lord of Tiberias 1172-1204, the lords of Beirut, Haifa, and Nazareth were vassals of the Prince of Galilee.

- Josselin III d'Edessa, seneschal of Jerusalem, *titular* count of Edessa, lord of Bainas (held of the lord of Beirut). Josselin's honor was primariy land granted out of the royal demesne near the city of Saint-Jean-d'Acre.
- Reynald de Chatillon, lord of Outrejourdain, Montreal and Kerak
- Walter II de Beirut, lord of Beirut, the lord of Bainas (Josselin of Edessa) and Toron were vassals of the baron of Beirut.
- Gerard Garnier, lord of Sidon, Prince of Sagette
- Juliana Garnier = Guy de Beirut, jure uxoris lord of Caeserea
- Lucia Dorel = Plivain of Genoa, *jure uxoris* lord of Botrun
- Humphrey IV de (Montfort) Toron, lord of Toron, the lords of Castel Neuf and Toron Ahmud were vassals of the baron of Toron.
- Baldwin d'Ibelin (of Chartres), lord of Ramleh
- Maria Comnena = Balian II d'Ibelin, chamberlain of Jerusalem, jure uxoris lord of Nablus and Ibelin. The castle of Ibelin had been granted to the Knights Hospitallers by Balian the Old, but the land remained in the care of the Ibelin family.
- Baldwin de (Ibelin) Mirabel, lord of Mirabel
- Pagan Carpenel, lord of Haifa
